- Introduction define the problem area, whose interested, why, etc.
- Research findings what is known, major studies, results, conflicting or controversial findings, consequences, etc.
- Outstanding or emerging research problems what needs to be studied, why, etc.
- Resource and infrastructure requirements what data, research methods, analysis tools, shared repositories, etc. are needed to address
